



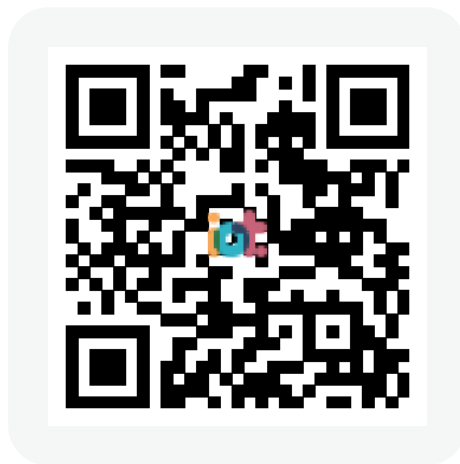

# WRITING TASK 1

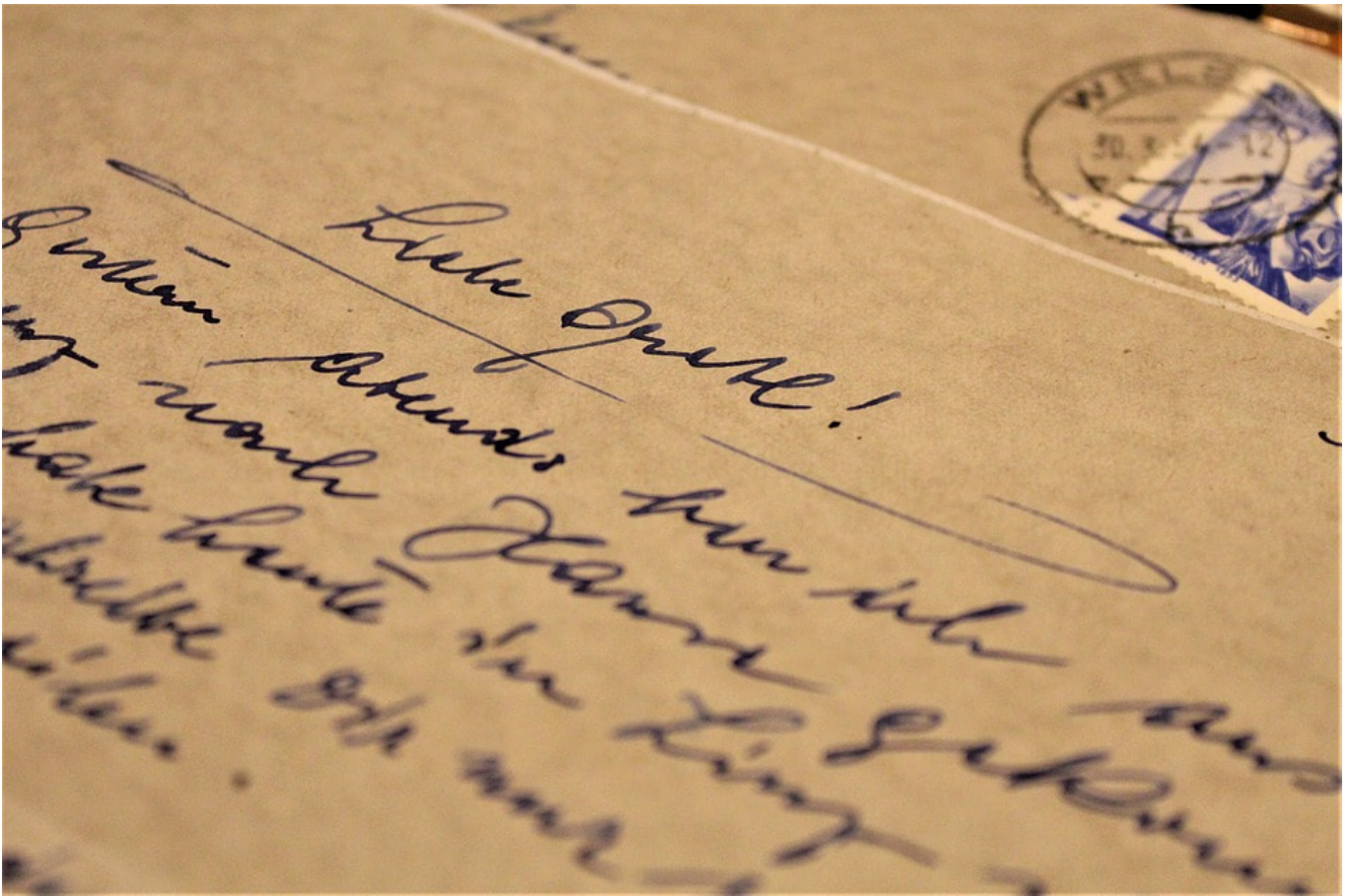
You should spend about **20** minutes on this task.
