
WRITING TASK 1

SAMPLE WRITING TASK 1

The diagrams depict how the modern cooking equipment evolved through three stages.

Originally the cooking used to be done with help of a pot supported by three stones at the bottom. The twigs and grass placed between the stones provided heat to the pot.

In the second stage, a protective clay shield was used around the stones, obviously to prevent heat loss and to protect the fire from winds. A cooking pot could be easily placed on top of it.

The modern cooking device (diagram C) is totally different in look and function. The fire is completely enclosed in a metal covering at the bottom. It has a front door for air supply and ash removal. The top consists of a grate on which charcoal can be placed. It is shielded by a clay-lining to prevent loss of heat. Besides a handle for easy transportation, the equipment has three metal supports at the top to keep the pot in balance.

In short, the simple cooking device underwent drastic changes before becoming a modern cooking equipment.

SAMPLE WRITING TASK 2

Although, economic development lead to increasing higher standards of living in mega cities, that has some bad effects in the long run time if the government does not pay more attention to the countryside.
