WRITING TASK 1


You should spend about 20 minutes on this task.

SAMPLE WRITING TASK 1

The diagrams illustrate two different methods to protect houses in the areas which are easily flooded.

Overall, the key distinction between two diagrams is the flood protection with or without the existence of a stopbank. In addition, in each case, the level of house floor is always above ground level.

The first diagram shows the way stopbank is used to prevent the river water from flooding the area. The stopbank is a mound of land locating near the berm which is always higher than the 100-year flood level. The difference between this level and the highest point of the stopbank called the 'freeboard'. Beneath the stopbank, there is a floodgate used to adjust the water level of internal ponding. Building the house on stills is also an additional measure to deal with flooding in this case.

The second diagram illustrates how to protect houses without the help of a stopbank. There will be nothing to stop the river from flooding, so the solution is raising the floor level by putting the houses on stills. The height of stills is calculated so that the floor level in this case is 300 mm above the 100-year flood level. This measurement is also known as the 'freeboard'.

SAMPLE WRITING TASK 1

The diagrams compare two different methods of defence for homes which are at risk of being flooded.

The key difference between the diagrams is that they show flood protection with and without a stopbank. In either case, the at-risk home is raised on stilts above ground level.

The first diagram shows how a stopbank acts as a flood barrier to stop river water from flooding homes. The stopbank is a small mound of land next to the river that is higher than the 100-year flood level, and prevents the river from bursting its banks. Nearby houses can be built on stilts to prevent flooding from rainwater, and a floodgate beneath the stopbank can be opened to allow this 'ponding' to drain off into the river.

When there is no stopbank, as shown in the second diagram, there will be nothing to stop the river from flooding. In this case, the solution is to put buildings on stilts. The height of the stilts is measured so that the floor of the house is 300mm above the 100-year flood level. This measurement is called the 'freeboard'.
