

# **SAMPLE WRITING TASK 1**

### Sample Band: 8.0

The chart illustrates average temperature and rainfall changes during the year in the city of Kolkata. The most noticeable trend is that the highest temperature during the whole period was in May whereas in July the greatest amount of precipitation can be found. At the same time, the lowest temperature observed in January and December and the lowest precipitation amount was in December. THIS IS FANTASTIC AND SHOWS A GOOD APPRECIATION OF THE INTRODUCTION.

Looking at the precipitation graph, the amount climbed from January to July and then slipped back until the end of the year. NEED DATA. MUST USE NUMBERS. The biggest change was in October when the rainfall plummeted more than three times compared with September. The temperature during the whole year didn't change drastically, and the lowest one was 20 degrees in December while the highest observed in May and was almost 30 degrees. In the beginning of the year, the temperature was surging modestly until the maximum in May and when started dropping until December.
